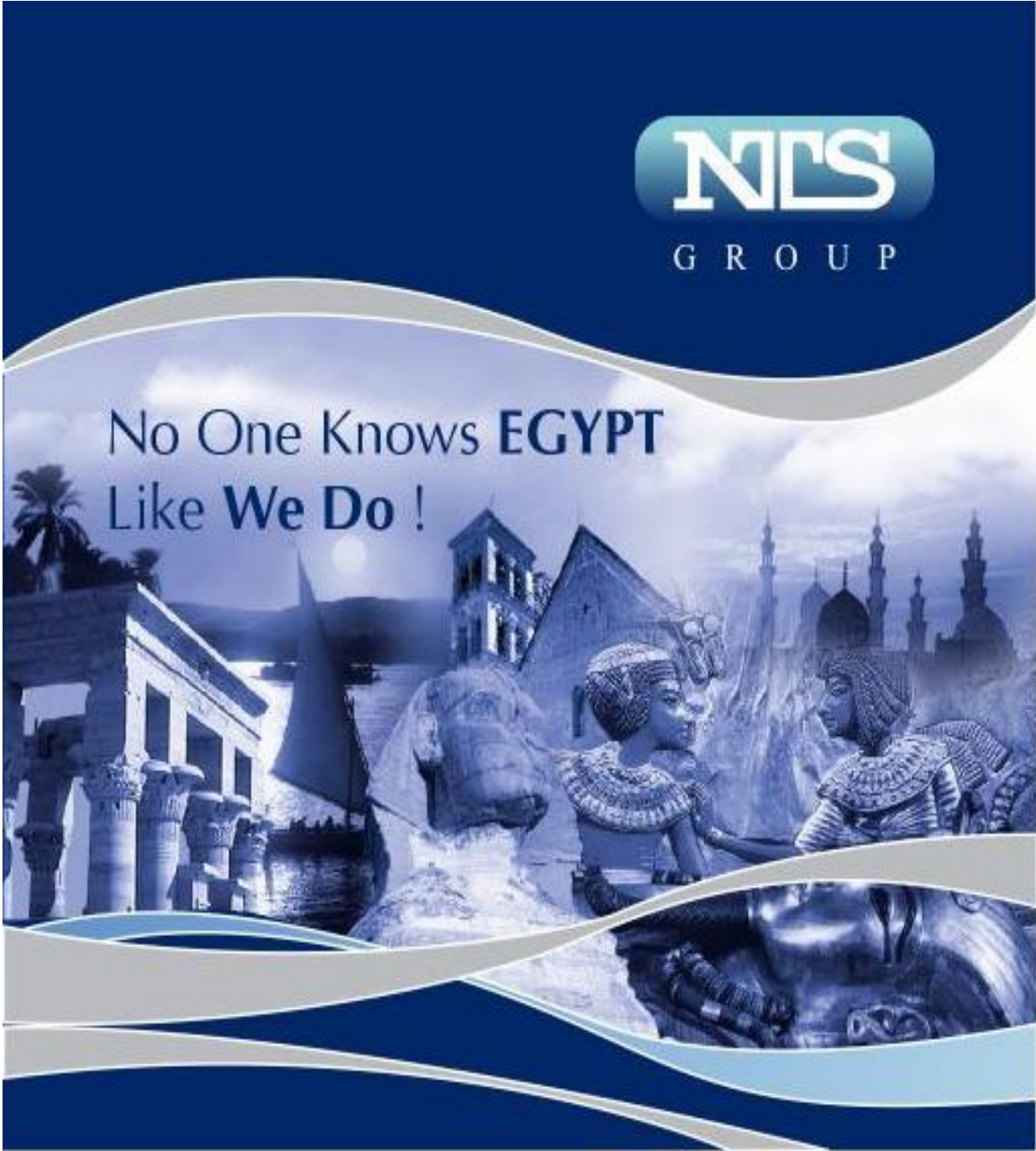


Company Profile
